

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids, in duplication, will be received by the Somerset County Sanitary District Commission, Inc. at 11916 Somerset Avenue, Room 216, P.O. Box 326 Princess Anne, Maryland 21853, until 2 p.m. local time, February 24, 2010 for the construction of the **Loretto Road Water Supply Project, Contract No. 044C035B**, at which time Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. All Bids hand carried to the Bid Opening should be brought to the Sanitary District Office prior to the closing time and date specified above.

Work for the project includes the following items of construction:

- Installation of approximately 1,750 LF of 8" water main and appurtenances in unpaved areas.
- Installation of approximately 50 LF of 10" water main by directional bore method.
- Conversion of a Test Well to a Production Well, including installation of a new pump, motor and appurtenances.
- Construction of a well building, including chemical feed equipment, process piping, mechanical, electrical and appurtenances.
- Construction of a gravel access road, miscellaneous sitework and grading.
- Installation of approximately 830 LF of 3" sewer forcemain in unpaved areas.
